

# Read eBooks from EBSCO on Your iPad: A How-to Guide

*This guide provides instructions on how to install the BlueFire Reader app on an iPad; download an eBook from the EBSCO eBook Collection onto your device; and open this eBook with BlueFire Reader.*

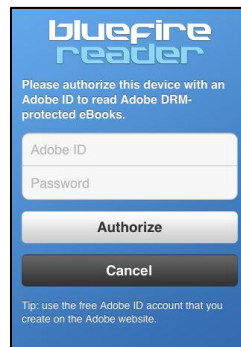
## Step 1: Install BlueFire Reader



- 1) Search the App Store and select and install BlueFire Reader.



- 2) Start BlueFire Reader. Authorize the device to read Adobe eBooks with your **Adobe ID**.

## Step 2: Download an eBook



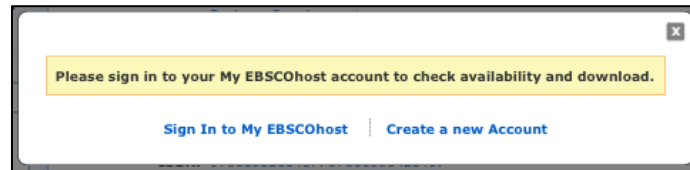
- 1) Use Safari to go to CSB/SJU Library's [EBSCO eBook Collection](#).

- 2) Search for an eBook. Click on an eBook title on the results page. You will see a record for your eBook like the one below.


Note: An eBook must have a **Download This eBook (Offline)** link for it to be downloadable. Click this link.



- 3) To complete your download, you will need to sign into your **My EBSCOhost** account. You will be given an option to create a new **My EBSCOhost** account if you don't already have one:

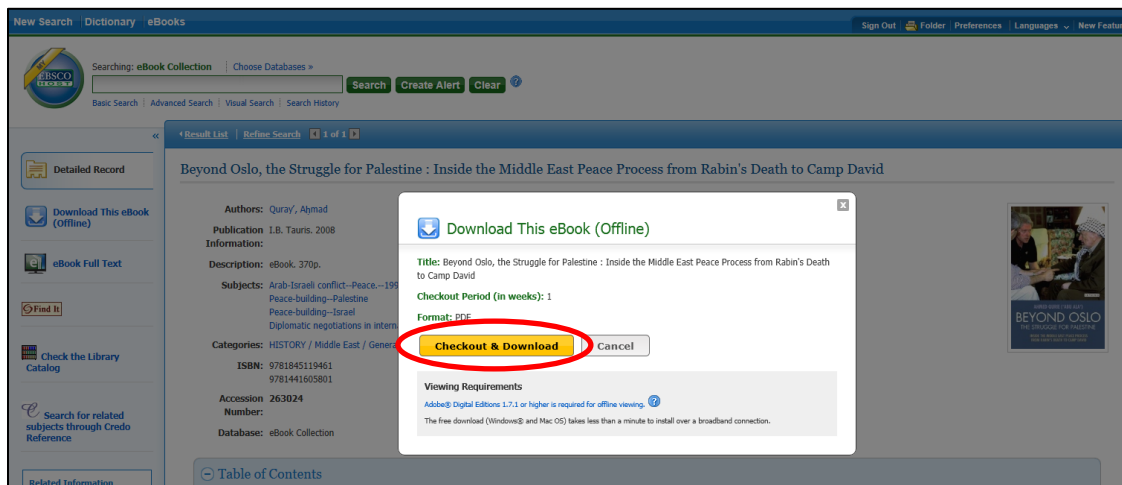


- 4) Enter your **My EBSCOhost** user name and password. Click **Login**.

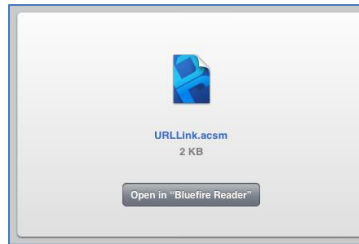


### Step 3: Open eBook with BlueFire Reader

- 1) When you see this screen, click the **Checkout & Download** link.



- 2) You will be given an option to open the eBook in BlueFire Reader. Click **Open in “Bluefire Reader.”**



- 3) Bluefire Reader will open and your eBook will download. Select **Read Now.**
